### \*\*\*New update on the Covid-19 Law \*\*\*

Due to the increase of the number of positive Covid-19 cases in Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, the Chamber of deputies decided to institute new sanitary rules.

Contrary to France and Belgium a new lockdown won't be applied but a curfew (between 11.00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m.) must be observed as from Friday 30 October and for one month period. Anyone encountered by the police after 11 p.m. must present a document proving their right to be outside.

In the private sphere, the "social bubble" is now limited to 4 people (instead of 10). This directive is also valid at home, in a club, in a restaurant until 31 December 2020

If the police won't be able to punish the non-respect of the rules in the private sphere, the penalty for non-compliance with sanitary instructions for bars and restaurants has been set at 4,000 Euros, up to 8.000 Euros in case of recidivism.

In supermarkets, the new standards are 1 customer per 10 m<sup>2</sup>, parking spaces will be limited accordingly and gatherings may not exceed 100 people.

Wearing a mask remains of course mandatory, and failure to comply with this rule will result in a fine of 45 euros.
