

CSSF and the Teleworking

The ongoing pandemic has changed the way we work, days of a full presence in offices are rare. The CSSF recently released Circular 21/769 in relation to Governance and Security requirements for entities teleworking.



CSSF approval is not required to telework instead the decision is of the entity's board. Plans to facilities telework and to ensure employees know the responsibilities associated with working outside the office space should be in place.

The increased use of remote devices brings more concerns for potential security risks. The pandemic has seen a rise in cyber security attacks and the CSSF reminds entities are to constantly monitor and improve their IT systems.

Ultimately, it is not up to the CSSF to decide how entities should implement home working but their aim is to inform of the risks and requirements that come with it. Entities themselves must adapt an approach to best suit their unique circumstances and business model.
