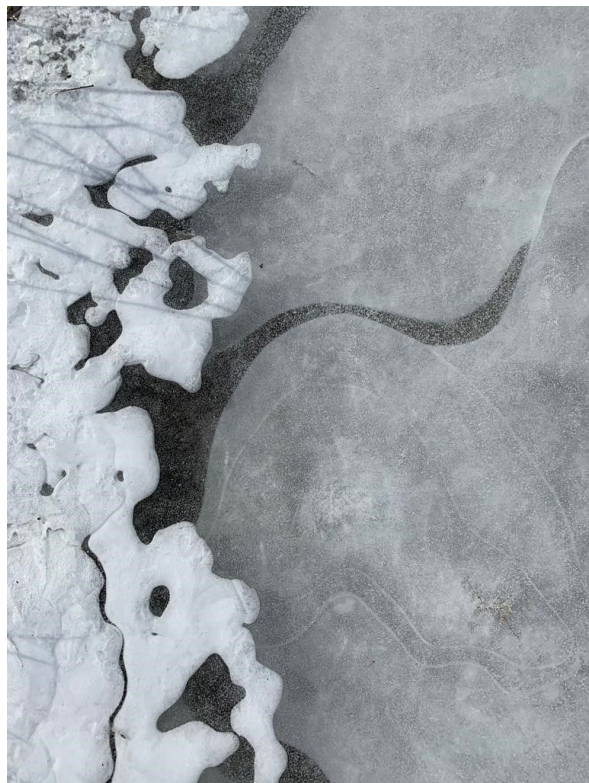




Securitization in Luxembourg on the rise despite pandemics

2020 has been a rather unruly year for the financial sector both globally and in Luxembourg. And the main reason for that was the Covid-19 outbreak, the effects of which have not yet completely subdued.
