A (not-so)-new breed of PE investment animal – SPAC – taking off in Luxembourg

A confident march of special purpose acquisition company (SPAC) in the US in the past decade is now an uncontested matter of fact, and their popularity is still on the rise with a greater number of high-caliber celebrities who are getting engaged with those.



So, what is a SPAC? A SPAC is basically a regular company formed for acquisition of yet-undefined business entities and introducing such entities to the stock market by means of a reverse merger, offering a comfortable gateway to listing to the target entities that would unlikely go public on their own – a sophisticated private equity investment tool for a range of risky investments.

And while the first Luxembourg SPAC was established only earlier this year and listed on the Frankfurt Stock Exchange, it is expected that the number of SPACs will grow steadily, with Luxembourg being a top EU financial hub with significant track record in the private equity investment sector.
