

The grand re-opening of restaurants, bars and cafés after the parliament vote last week

Since the passing of the latest Covid-19 law last week, restaurants and cafés in Luxembourg are now finally able to serve their clients both indoors and outdoors. But things are not yet completely normal as it used to be in the pre-Covid-19 era because some Covid-19 related restrictions remain in place.

So, while enjoying a meal or a drink either alone or in a very small company outdoors is possible without significant constraints as before, the same is not exactly true for eating inside – inside food and beverage consumption is only possible when presenting a negative Covid-19 result at the door of the hospitality establishment.

The new measures are temporarily in nature and will last until mid-June 2021 (unless extended), hence it is high time to procure a commercially available rapid Covid-19 test and enjoy the-about-to-come nice summer weather in the Grand Duchy while having a light lunch, dinner or aperitif at one of the numerous local hospitality establishments. Last but not least curfew is now extended to midnight.
